Thematic stamps relating to the Antarctic have been issued by countries all over the world. Famous explorers, scientific research, wildlife, Antarctic Treaty anniversaries, ships, space, and aircraft are just some of the hundreds of subjects portrayed on these ever popular issues. Antarctica is the last frontier on earth—remote, inhospitable, largely unexplored and dangerous, yet fantastically beautiful, and scientifically fascinating. It is these aspects plus the heroic deeds of its early explorers which grip the imagination of so many people world wide, not the least being stamp collectors. Their stamps are probably the most popular of all thematics, or regions. There are currently over 20 countries with bases on the Antarctic including the 13 original signatories of the Antarctic Treaty. The following is a list of items in stock.
